

MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING CONDUCTED IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS,
NORMAL CITY HALL, FOURTH FLOOR UPTOWN STATION, 11 UPTOWN CIRCLE,
NORMAL, MCLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS – MONDAY, DECEMBER 3, 2018 –
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) CITIZEN PARTICIPATION
PLAN.

1. CALL TO ORDER:
