Enforcement of Stay-at-Home Executive Order

EFFECTIVE DATE: 4/4/2020 EFFECTIVE TIME: 4:00 P.M.

Under the authority granted by Ordinance No. 5824, and by the Governor's Executive Orders 2020-10 and 2020-18, the Mayor, upon the recommendation of the City Manager, orders as follows:

1. Purpose and Intent

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Illinois Governor issued Executive Order 2020-10, which is a Stay-at-Home Order, prohibiting gatherings of more than 10 people and requiring people to remain at home other than to engage in essential activities.

The Governor issued Executive Order 2020-18, extending the Stay-at-Home Order through April 30, 2020.

Executive Order 2020-10 authorizes enforcement of its provisions by local law enforcement.

The failure to follow the requirements of the Stay-At-Home Order endanger the health and safety of the community.

The intent of this Order is to clarify that Town of Normal Police Officers and other appropriate personnel are fully authorized to respond to violations of the Stay-at-Home Order and take all necessary and appropriate actions to enforce that Order.

2. Enforcement Actions

Upon violations of an Executive Order, Town Staff will engage in community caretaking and contact the individuals in violations to educate and redirect them to gain voluntary compliance with the Executive Order.


Police Officers are authorized to direct a person to leave a certain location and return to his or her residence if their behavior falls outside of allowed conduct.

Police Officers are authorized to issue ordinance violations or institute criminal charges, based on reckless conduct, disorderly conduct, or other offenses as appropriate under the circumstances.

3. Department Regulation


Nothing in this Order will be deemed to limit the actions available to Town Staff in the enforcement of the Stay-at-Home Order or any other law. Nothing in this Order will be deemed to supplant the discretion of an Town Staff in the proper discharge of his or her duties. It is the responsibility of each Department Head to issue necessary directives and policies for the proper enforcement of the Stay-at-Home Order. Nothing in this Order will be deemed to preempt those directives and policies.
