Suspension of Solicitation Licenses

Under the authority granted by Ordinance No. 5824, the Mayor, upon the recommendation of the City Manager, orders as follows:

**1. Purpose and Intent**

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Illinois Governor issued Executive Order 2020-10, which is a Stay-at-Home Order, which, among other things, prohibits the operation of nonessential businesses.

The Governor issued Executive Order 2020-18, extending the Stay-at-Home Order through April 30, 2020.

The Town of Normal licenses to solicitors who make door-to-door sales.


Door-to-door sales represent a unique challenge to the requirements for social distancing and the conduct of non-essential business under the Governor's Executive Order, and they represent a danger to the health and safety of the community.

The intent of this Order is to suspend licenses for solicitors during the term of the Governor's Stay-at-Home Order.

**2. License Suspensions**


All Solicitor licenses issued under Division 4 of Chapter 22 of the Normal Town Code are hereby suspended during the term of the Governor's Executive Order 2020-10, as extended by Executive Order 2020-18 or as otherwise extended.
